Conduct

The Traveling Dojo's programs are intended for students who are serious about martial arts and self-defense, and as such we require students to always conduct themselves with respect towards the instructors, fellow students, facility leaders and everyone with whom they are in contact.

I agree to follow all rules and instructions given by the instructors to ensure safety and discipline within the training environment.

I understand that failure to adhere to these rules may result in my dismissal from the program without a refund.

Karate Oath

Each student enrolled in the martial arts program is required to learn and recite the Traveling Dojo's Karate Oath. Reciting and understanding the oath is an important aspect to our martial arts training and is a requirement of each belt rank promotion.
